<p>LANGUAGE AND LITERACY (reading, speaking, listening)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will startle to unfamiliar sounds, respond to familiar sounds, repeat sounds originated by care adults, and look towards sounds. • Children will look at or move toward named person or object, repeat sounds initiated by adults, use newly developed vocabulary to name things. <p>STANDARDS: 1.1 I.C, 1.3 I.J</p>	<p>COGNITIVE (sensory, science, math, thinking, reasoning)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will reach for and move to objects and people, explore using all senses. • Children will look at self in mirror, aim gaze at names person when asked (where’s mommy, daddy, etc. <p>STANDARDS: 3.1 I.A, 3.1 I.B.1</p>	<p>SOCIAL/EMOTIONAL (self-awareness/management, relationships, behavior)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will Move toward mirrors in the environment, smile when held to mirror, coo when looking in mirror, point and babble at self in mirror. • Children will cry or use inappropriate action to express frustrations. <p>STANDARDS: 16.1 I.E, 16.2 I.D</p>
