



Community Standards of Friends Child Care Center

Friends Child Care Center seeks to provide a safe, stimulating learning environment for its children and families that is friendly, courteous, and expresses the core values of the Religious Society of Friends. We believe that there is that of God in every person, and all individuals-both children and adults are to be respected. With this in mind, we ask staff, parents and children to treat one another and the physical space with courtesy and respect. We also ask those who use the space to be mindful of the human impact on the natural environment and to take care to minimize their use of energy, water, and other resources.

Adherence to these basic standards is expected of all FCCC staff, parents, volunteers and guests. You are

expected to:

- Treat all persons with respect without regard to job title, age, gender, race, sexual orientation or any other way in which the human family is sometimes subdivided.
- For the wellbeing of all, smoking is not permitted in Friends Center buildings, on Friends Center grounds, or within 20 feet of windows and doors into Friends Center.
- You are required to show your FCCC IDs upon entering the building, or sign in as a guest if you do not have the ID in your possession.
- Be courteous and understanding of front desk staff when/if asked for your ID.
- Weapons are prohibited from the child care as they violate state regulations and basic child care safety rules. Law enforcement agents on official business are the exception.
- Illegal substances are prohibited.
- Persons who appear to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol are not permitted to pick up children.
- Children should not be left unattended in hallways, at the front lobby and in the courtyard nor should children be allowed to exit the front entrance without an adult escort.
- Be courteous and fold strollers whether storing in play yard shed or in storage cage in the basement. Space is limited.
- Be sure to update emergency contact forms with current information of those to whom your child may be released. We must have your written consent prior to releasing your child to anyone but the parents. (Including another parent or staff.)
- If an unsafe condition is observed or a repair needed, please report it to the Office Manager.
